Applicants to both open rank positions must demonstrate an ability to develop a successful academic record including funded research, teaching, and scholarly publications. The candidates selected for these positions must be able to meet eligibility requirements for work in the United States at the time the appointment is scheduled to begin and continue working legally for the proposed term of employment; excellent communication skills required. Review of applications will begin September 15th, 2009 and continue until the candidates are selected and recommended for appointment.
